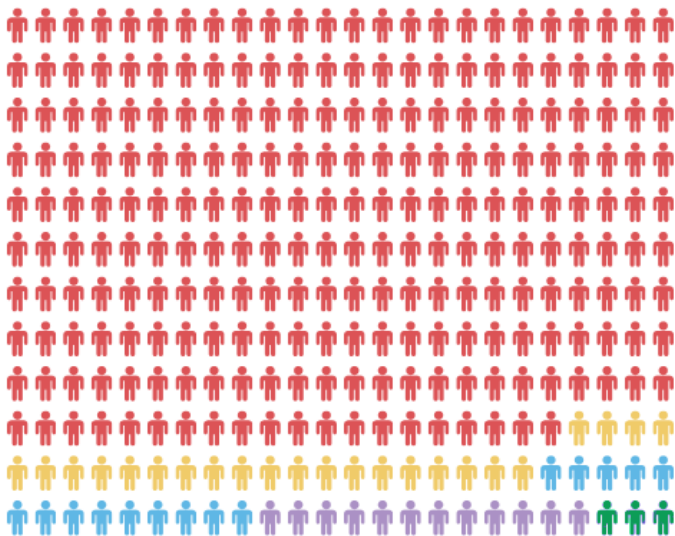

COMMITTEE FOCUS

Agri-Business Committee Actively involved in supporting local agricultural businesses and agri-tourism enterprises. The group also supports the Muskogee Regional Jr. Livestock Show.
(The committee meets the 2nd Thursday of the month September – May at 3:30pm)

Ambassadors Committee Focuses on member involvement and retention. As the “welcome arm” of the Chamber, ambassadors attend Ribbon Cuttings, Groundbreaking Ceremonies, and Open Houses.
(The committee meets the first Wednesday of the month at 12:00 Noon)

Golf Classic Committee Coordinates the Annual Chamber Golf Classic held in April each year. These volunteers solicit sponsorships, recruit players, create contests and secure prizes.
(The committee meets March and April)

Magic Promotions Committee Coordinates the community – wide retail promotion designed to support local merchants.
(The committee meets August – December)

Military Affairs Committee Focuses on building relationships between the community and Camp Gruber, as well as strengthen the relationship between the citizens of Muskogee and the military and veteran personnel and their families in the Muskogee area.
(The committee meets on the first Thursday of each month at 4:00pm)

(The committee meets the 3rd Friday of every month at 7:30am)

Paul Revere Legislative Affairs Committee Monitors state and federal legislative activities on behalf of Muskogee businesses.
(The committee meets the 4th Friday of every month)

Wellness Task Force Coordinates and focuses on workplace wellness initiatives and preventive healthcare to increase your bottom line. Wellness run, walk, bike programs.
(The committee meets as needed)

Women’s Leadership Conference Committee Plans the Women’s Leadership Conference held in July, including keynote speakers, panels, breakout sessions, and style show.
