All applications must be received at the Chamber Office, no later than 5:00 p.m., September 13, 2019. You will be notified of the Selection Committee’s decision no later than Monday, September 30, 2019.

Tuition is due and payable prior to the Orientation Retreat on October 24th & 25th of 2019.

TUITION

Tuition for the program is \$750.00 for Chamber Members and \$950.00 for Non-Chamber Members. Tuition covers all program costs, materials, meals, and on-site transportation.
